

ORDINANCE NO. 79-84

An ordinance to appropriate funds to pay the cost of repairs to property located at the Bexley Community Swimming Pool in Jeffrey Park and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$10,000.00 should be and it is hereby appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund and transferred to the Auditor's Miscellaneous Account to be used to pay the costs of repair to the property located at the Bexley Community Swimming Pool in Jeffrey Park.

Section 2. That the expenditures are for a variety of matters in the nature of repairs and maintenance to the property and furnishing to enable the pool to prepare for its opening on Memorial Day and no single item is sufficiently expensive to invoke the bidding requirements of state law.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety; therefore, such Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and its approval by the Mayor.
