

ORDINANCE NO. 37-84

An ordinance to appropriate funds to complete the 1983 Franklin County Permissive License Tax Project.

WHEREAS, the amount of \$59,544.00 was appropriated in 1983 to pay the entire cost of the Franklin County Permissive License Tax Project; and

WHEREAS, this project involved the street improvements to Drexel Avenue and traffic signal improvements at the intersections of Cassingham Road and Mound Street and Remington Road and Maryland Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the necessary supplies and equipment to complete the traffic signal improvements were not received in time to complete the project on 1983; and

WHEREAS, the amount necessary to complete the project was not encumbered in the 1984 annual appropriation ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the amount of \$25,958.02 should be and it is hereby set aside and appropriated from the Street Fund to pay the cost for completion of the 1983 Franklin County Permissive License Tax Project.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
