

ORDINANCE NO. 38-84

An ordinance to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to advertise for bids for the repair of sidewalks at various locations in the City of Bexley, to appropriate funds, and to declare an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they are hereby authorized and directed after advertisement according to law, to enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder for the replacement of cement concrete sidewalks at various locations in the City.

Section 2. That the amount of \$26,000.00 be and it is hereby appropriated and set aside from the Sidewalk Fund for the contract and to pay for the other miscellaneous items required for this project and that the contract, as specified, shall not exceed the balance of the appropriation.

Section 3. That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, and this Ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
