

ORDINANCE NO. 42 -84

An ordinance to appropriate various sums from the unencumbered General Fund for transfer to and adjustment of other accounts and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$ 17,374.27 should be and it is hereby appropriated and set aside and transferred from the unencumbered General Fund to the Police Station Building Fund to be used to complete the payment, pursuant to contract, of the police station renovation.

Section 2. That the sum of \$ 13,000.00 should be and it is hereby appropriated and set aside and transferred from the unencumbered General Fund to the Police Pension Fund to fulfill and complete the City's obligation to such fund for 1984.

Section 3. That the sum of \$ 5,000.00 should be and it is hereby appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund and transferred to the appropriate accounts within said fund for insurance purposes to be used to pay the City's 1984 obligations for insurance purchased.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and this Ordinance shall go into full force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
