

ORDINANCE NO. 48 -84

An ordinance to purchase a new 1985 vehicle for police department, to be used as a marked cruiser, to replace vehicle demolished in an accident and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$11,000.00 should be and it is hereby transferred from unencumbered General Fund to the Capital Improvements Fund, Account No. 13-820-144, and further appropriated and set aside from such fund to be used to purchase a new 1985 motor vehicle and accessories to be used by the Police Department as a marked vehicle to replace the vehicle demolished in the automobile accident.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they are hereby authorized and directed, after advertisement according to law, to enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder for said vehicle, the total cost of which shall not exceed the sum so specified and appropriated, and the complete specifications for which have been prepared and are on file in the office of the Mayor.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
