

ORDINANCE NO. 52-84

An ordinance to authorize the City Planner to provide planning services regarding additional and expanded recreational facilities for the City of Bexley, to appropriate funds and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the City Planner for the City of Bexley is hereby authorized and directed to provide planning services regarding additional and expanded recreational facilities for the City of Bexley, which shall include among other projects the analysis of the best uses for the Jeffrey Mansion facility and the possible development of several alternative locations within the City for additional recreational facilities.

Section 2. That the sum of \$7,000.00 shall be appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund and transferred to the City Planner's account to be used for these purposes, and that the City Planner shall bill the City on the same basis as for other services provided.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety and this Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
