An Ordinance to appropriate additional funds for the 1984 Fiscal Year.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$3,200.00 be appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered Refuse Fund for the purpose of renting a backhoe/front-end loader for use in the 1984 fall leaf collection project.

Section 2. That the sum of \$3,000.00 be appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of providing additional funding for the Clemans, Nelson and Associates, Inc. contract to provide, on a priority basis, such employee relations and personnel services as might be required for the duration of this agreement.

Section 3. That the sum of \$2,560.00 be appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered Refuse Fund for the purpose of contracting for temporary secretarial help in the Service Department because of an existing vacancy.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
