An ordinance to appropriate various additional sums for the operation of City Hall and for the increased costs of employee benefits and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$1,073.00 should be and it is hereby appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund and specifically assigned to Account 13-825-144.1, the Lobby Furniture Account for City Hall, to be used to pay the costs of new furniture purchased during fiscal year 1984.

Section 2. The following sums should be, and they are, hereby appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund and specifically assigned as follows:

(a) The sum of \$1,000.00 to Account 01-310-131, Office Supplies, City Hall, to pay additional operating expenses from that account for fiscal year 1984;

(b) The sum of \$1,000.00 to Account 01-310-132, Operating Supplies, City Hall, to pay additional expenses from that account for fiscal year 1984;

(c) The sum of \$800.00 to Account 01-310-133, Repairs and Maintenance, City Hall, to pay additional expenses from that account for fiscal year 1984;

(d) The sum of \$500.00 to Account 01-310-127, Miscellaneous Expense, City Hall, to pay additional expense from that account for fiscal year 1984;

(e) The sum of \$200.00 to Account 01-150-127, Miscellaneous Expense, City Council, to pay additional expenses from that account for fiscal year 1984;

(f) The sum of \$18,000.00 to Account 01-950-107, City Health Insurance, Employees, to pay additional costs of such insurance for fiscal year 1984; and

(g) The sum of \$9,311.63 to Account 01-950-103, Public Employees Retirement System, to pay additional obligations of the City on behalf of the city employees for fiscal year 1984.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, and this Ordinance shall to into full force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
