

ORDINANCE NO. 61 -84

An ordinance to appropriate additional funds to pay the costs of updating the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bexley by the Justinian Publishing Company and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the City of Bexley, pursuant to ordinance, had previously entered into a contract with Justinian Publishing Company for the continual updating of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bexley for a period of five (5) years which contract provided for an annual review and updating of the Codified Ordinances, the costs of which were to be paid on the basis of a set fee for editorial services and a per page cost for replacement services;

Section 2. That the City of Bexley in Ordinance 1-84 had previously appropriated the sum of \$3,000.00 for such services and allocated that amount to account number 01-170-119;

Section 3. That the total costs of services for the year 1984, pursuant to the contract, are in the amount of \$3,767.91;

Section 4. That the additional sum of \$800.00 should be and it is hereby appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund and assigned to account number 01-170-119 to pay the additional costs incurred under the contract;

Section 5. That this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and this Ordinance shall go into full force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
