ordinance no. 62 -84 An ordinance to increase the salary of the Auditor of the City of Bexley, effective as of the term of office commencing January 1, 1986 and thereafter, to repeal all previous salary ordinances regarding the position of Auditor, and to declare an emergency. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO: Section 1. That Article V, Section 33 of the Charter of the City of Bexley provides that an Auditor shall be elected for a term of four years, that he shall be the fiscal officer of the City and that he shall perform all the duties and exercise all powers conferred upon him by the Charter, the ordinances of the City of Bexley and the general laws of the State of Ohio; Section 2. That such article further provides, inter alia, that the salary of the Auditor may be increased by ordinance of Council passed at least one year prior to the beginning of the term thereby to be affected; Section 3. That the present term of office for the Auditor expires as of the end of the year 1985 and that the new term of office commences as of January 1, 1986; Section 4. That the salary for the office of Auditor for the City of Bexley should be and it is hereby increased to the amount of \$15,000.00 for the year commencing January 1, 1986, to \$15,500.00 for the year commencing January 1, 1987, to \$16,000.00 for the year commencing January 1, 1988, and to \$16,500.00 for the year commencing January 1, 1989, and that all other previous ordinances regarding the salary of Auditor inconsistent herewith are hereby superceded and Section 5. That this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and this Ordinance shall go into full force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
