A Resolution authorizing the Mayor to apply for a litter control grant from the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, Office of Litter Control, and to authorize the administration of said grant if awarded.

WHEREAS, the Bexley City Council recognizes the existence of a litter problem within the boundaries of Bexley as it pertains to the disposal of trash, rubbish, yard trimmings, leaves and brush; and

WHEREAS, the Bexley City Council recognizes the need to address this problem at the local level through a coordinated effort as described in the application for a litter control grant. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: That the Bexley City Council hereby endorses and supports a litter control program for Bexley and shall authorize the necessary funds to implement said program, if approved, as indicated in the grant application.

Section 2: That the Mayor is hereby authorized to apply for said litter control grant and shall administer the grant, if awarded, for the City of Bexley.
