

RESOLUTION NO. 3 -86

WHEREAS, passage of Issue 1 will enable COTA to assure continued excellence and provide an immediate response to the county's transit needs continuing through 1996; and,

WHEREAS, Columbus and Franklin County will become established as a national convention and trade show center through the construction of the New World Center; and,

WHEREAS, Franklin County residents will benefit from innovative money allocation practices by funding both COTA and construction of the New World Center with the same one-half percent sales tax; and,

WHEREAS, passage of Issue 1 will create 6,000 new jobs and protect thousands of jobs related to the convention industry and jobs related to a strong public transit system; and,

WHEREAS, passage of Issue 1 will act as a catalyst in spurring further development of the Downtown area and Franklin County as a whole; and,
