

ORDINANCE NO. 13 - 86

An Ordinance to appropriate additional funds to pay the cost of emergency sewer repairs as a result of a sanitary sewer line collapse on North Parkview Avenue.

WHEREAS, on February 4, 1986 an eight inch diameter sanitary sewer main was discovered to be collapsed on North Parkview Avenue at a location approximately five hundred feet south of Caroline Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the collapsed line was obstructing the flow of sewerage causing a backup of raw sewerage into the basement of houses located upstream from the broken pipe; and

WHEREAS, the situation was deemed to be an emergency by the Service Director who determined it was necessary to contract with the Woodward Excavating Company to make the necessary repairs without benefit of appropriated funds for this purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That the sum of \$2,500.00 be, and it hereby is, appropriated from the unencumbered Sewer Fund, to reimburse the Sanitary Sewer Maintenance and Repair Account for the cost of emergency sewer repairs on North Parkview Avenue.

Section 2: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
