

ORDINANCE NO. 14 - 86

An Ordinance to appropriate additional funds to pay the cost of completing the Sanitary Sewer Flow Measurement Study on the Chelsea Avenue Sanitary Sewer Line.

WHEREAS, the Chelsea Avenue Sanitary Sewer Flow Measurement Study was authorized by City Council and implemented by the Service Director in 1985; and

WHEREAS, the amount of funds requested in the 1986 Appropriation Ordinance has been determined to be insufficient to pay the cost of completing this study due to a carry-over of unpaid invoices from the 1985 budget year and a malfunction of the computerized equipment which will require an extension of the original completion date.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That the sum of \$4,000.00 should be, and it hereby is, appropriated from the unencumbered Sewer Fund to pay the cost of engineering fees for the completion of the Chelsea Avenue Sanitary Sewer Flow Measurement Study.

Section 2: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
