An Ordinance to appropriate funds to pay the legal fees of special counsel and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY,
OHIO:

Section 1: That the sum of \$2,828.45 should be, and it hereby is, appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying legal fees of Knepper White Arter & Hadden, special counsel to the City in litigation styled as Seymour v. City of Bexley.

Section 2: That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety; and, therefore, such Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
