

ORDINANCE NO. 21 - 86

An Ordinance to appropriate additional funds to pay the cost of emergency sewer repairs as a result of an improper connection of a sanitary sewer house lateral to a non-functioning abandoned private sewer line at the rear of 75 South Cassingham Road.

WHEREAS, on March 14, 1986 it was discovered that the sanitary sewer house lateral for the property at 75 South Cassingham Road was improperly connected to a non-functioning and abandoned private sewer line located within the alley right-of-way at the rear of the property; and

WHEREAS, the City records indicate that a Sanitary Sewer Permit, Number 1647, was issued for the property on June 9, 1928 to connect the City's sanitary sewer line located approximately four feet east and three feet deeper than the abandoned private line; and

WHEREAS, it can be reasonably assumed that the original connection of this house lateral to the sewer system was improperly made by the sewer contractor and was not discovered by the City Inspector; and

WHEREAS, the Service Director has recommended that the cost of the necessary repairs to properly connect the house lateral to the sanitary sewer system be paid by the City because the City Inspector approved the original connection 58 years ago and the present owner of the property should not be penalized for this error.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That the sum of \$1,940.00 be, and it hereby is, appropriated from the unencumbered Sewer Fund, to reimburse the Sanitary Sewer Maintenance and Repair Account for the cost of the emergency sewer repairs as described above.

Section 2: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
