

ORDINANCE NO. 24 -86

An Ordinance to authorize the transfer of funds from the General Fund to the Capital Improvements Fund, to appropriate funds from the Capital Improvements Fund and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That \$49,500 be, and the same hereby is, transferred from the unencumbered General Fund to the Capital Improvements Fund.

Section 2. That \$39,000 be, and it hereby is, appropriated from the Capital Improvements Fund for the purchase of three police cruisers.

Section 3. That \$10,500 be appropriated from the Capital Improvements Fund for the purchase of a van for use by the Police Department.

Section 4. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into a contract for the purchase of three police cruisers, the total cost of which shall not exceed \$39,000, specified and appropriated above, and the complete specifications for which have been prepared and are on file in the office of the Mayor.

Section 5. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into a contract for the purchase of a new 1986 van for use by the Police Department, the total cost of which shall not exceed \$10,500, specified and appropriated above, and the complete specifications for which have been prepared and are on file in the office of the Mayor.

Section 6. That \$3,590 be appropriated from the Capital Improvements Fund for the purchase of a typewriter for the Mayor's Office.

Section 7. That \$400 be appropriated from the Capital Improvements Fund for the purchase of a used typewriter for the Building Department.

Section 8. That the contracts authorized herein, when required by law, shall be entered into with the lowest and best bid after advertisement according to law.

Section 9. That this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
