

ORDINANCE NO. 27 -86

An Ordinance to authorize the transfer of funds from the General Fund to the Capital Improvements Fund, to appropriate funds from the Capital Improvements Fund and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY,  
OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$12,350.00 be, and it hereby is, transferred from the unencumbered General Fund to the Capital Improvements Fund.

Section 2. That the sum of \$12,350.00 be, and it hereby is, appropriated from the Capital Improvements Fund for the following uses in the amounts specified:
