

ORDINANCE NO. 33 -86

An Ordinance to appropriate funds to pay consulting fees and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY,  
OHIO:

Section 1: That the sum of \$40,000.00 should be, and it hereby is, appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying consulting fees of Clemans, Nelson & Associates, Inc. pursuant to said company's contract with the City.

Section 2: That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety; and, therefore, such Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
