

ORDINANCE NO. 39-86

An Ordinance to appropriate funds to pay the cost of boarding prisoners at the Franklin County Jail and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY,
OHIO:

Section 1: That the sum of \$6,000.00 should be, and it hereby is, appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying costs of boarding prisoners at the Franklin County Jail.

Section 2: That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety; and, therefore, such Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
