

ORDINANCE NO. 45-86

An Ordinance to appropriate funds to pay the legal fees of the City Solicitor and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY,  
OHIO:

Section 1. That \$1,785.40 be, and it hereby is, appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying legal fees and expenses of the City Solicitor with respect to litigation styled as Goldberger, et al. v. City of Bexley and Martin v. Bexley Board of Education, respectively.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety; and, therefore, such Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
