

ORDINANCE NO. 47-86

An Ordinance to authorize a contract with the Columbus Neighborhood Design Assistance Center, to appropriate funds and to declare an emergency.

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Auditor be, and each of them hereby is, authorized and directed to execute an agreement with the Columbus Neighborhood Design Assistance Center for planning services with respect to enhancement of the commercial sectors of the City on such terms and conditions as shall be approved by the City Solicitor.

Section 2. That the sum of \$5,000 should be, and it hereby is, appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund to pay the consulting fees of the Columbus Neighborhood Design Assistance Center.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and this Ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
