

ORDINANCE NO. 50 - 86

An Ordinance to authorize the Service Director to enter into a contract for emergency sewer repairs on the Parkview Avenue sanitary sewer line, to appropriate necessary funds, and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, a closed circuit television inspection of the Parkview Avenue sanitary sewer line has disclosed two sections of broken and missing pipe between Broad Street and Powell Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the broken and missing pipe sections may result in a collapse of the sanitary sewer line causing interruption of service to a number of houses connected to the sewer line; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 735.051 provides, in the case of a real and present emergency, the legislative authority by a two-thirds vote of all members to authorize the director of public service to enter into a contract for work to be done without formal bidding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the amount of \$6,000.00 should be, and it hereby is, appropriated from the unencumbered Sewer Fund to pay the cost of emergency sewer repairs to the Parkview Avenue sanitary sewer line.

Section 2. That the Service Director is authorized by a two-thirds vote of all members of the Bexley City Council to contract for said repairs without formal bidding and advertising.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety; said emergency being the need to repair the sewer pipe without delay to eliminate the danger of a collapse; and therefore, such Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
