Section 2. That the Mayor and the Auditor be, and each of them hereby is, authorized and directed to execute an agreement with the Bexley Chamber of Commerce to assist financially the Chamber's task force studying ways to enhance the commercial sectors of the City, said agreement to be on such terms and conditions as shall be approved by the City Solicitor.

Section 3. That the sum of \$5,000 should be, and it hereby is, appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund, said funds to be used by the Bexley Chamber of Commerce to pay the fees of the Chamber's planning consultant.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and this Ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
