

ORDINANCE NO. 63 -86

An Ordinance to transfer and appropriate funds for improvements to the Bexley swimming pool and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY,  
OHIO:

Section 1: That the sum of \$2,100 should be, and it hereby is, transferred from the unencumbered General Fund to the Capital Improvements Fund.

Section 2: That the sum of \$2,100 should be, and it hereby is, appropriated and set aside from the Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of paying the cost of certain improvements to the Bexley swimming pool.

Section 3: That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety; and, therefore, such Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
