

ORDINANCE NO. 68⁷-86

An Ordinance to establish the position of Receptionist and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That the position of Receptionist should be, and it hereby is, established.

Section 2: That the annual salary for the position of Receptionist should be, and it hereby is, established at \$10,000-\$13,856.

Section 3: That the position of Receptionist should be, and it hereby is, designated a Schedule II employee entitled to the benefits prescribed by ordinance for such class of employees.

Section 4: That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety since the services of a receptionist are needed at the earliest possible date to serve members of the public who have business at the Bexley Municipal Building; and, therefore, such Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
