

ORDINANCE NO. 65-86

An Ordinance to transfer and appropriate funds for the remodeling of the lobby of the Bexley Municipal Building and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY,
OHIO:

Section 1: That the sum of \$15,000 should be, and it hereby is, transferred from the unencumbered General Fund to the Capital Improvement Fund.

Section 2: That the sum of \$15,000 should be, and it hereby is, appropriated and set aside from the Capital Improvement Fund for the purpose of paying the costs of remodeling the lobby of the Bexley Municipal Building and purchasing furniture, fixtures and equipment in connection therewith.

Section 3: That the Mayor and the Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into one or more contracts for the improvements specified in Section 1 hereof, the total cost of which shall not exceed the amount specified and appropriated.

Section 4: That the contracts authorized herein, when required by law, shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law.

Section 5: That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety since it is necessary to commence the remodeling at the earliest possible date to serve members of the public who have business at the Bexley Municipal Building; and, therefore, such Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
