

ORDINANCE NO. 66-86

An Ordinance to appropriate funds for planning services in connection with the remodeling of Jeffrey Mansion, to authorize services of the City planning consultant and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That the sum of \$3,600 should be, and it hereby is, appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying the fees of the City's planning consultant in connection with the preparation of plans by said consultant for the remodeling of the basement of Jeffrey Mansion as a teen center and for other uses.

Section 2: That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety since there is an immediate need in the community for a teen center and it is necessary to commence the remodeling at the earliest possible date; and, therefore, such Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
