

ORDINANCE NO. 69 - 86

An Ordinance to appropriate an additional amount of \$1,911.00 from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund for the purchase of a truck chassis with a ten foot dump body for use by the Street Department; and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 4-86 appropriated \$23,000.00 for the purchase of said truck; and

WHEREAS, the lowest and best bid was received in the amount of \$24,911.00 which exceeds the original appropriation by \$1,911.00; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to accept this bid because it is unlikely a lower bid will be received if it is re-bid, and there are available funds in the Capital Improvement Fund to complete the purchase.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That \$1,911.00 be and the same hereby is appropriated from the Capital Improvements Fund for the purchase of a truck chassis and ten foot dump body in accordance with bids received by the Service Department.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the approach of the winter season and that the truck to be purchased will be used in snow removal operations, and that this Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
