

ORDINANCE NO. 76 -86

An Ordinance to appropriate \$1,200.00 from the unencumbered General Fund for the payment of a Receptionist's Salary for the year 1986.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 64-86 established the position of Receptionist; and,

WHEREAS, necessary funding to pay the salary of the position of Receptionist was omitted from Ordinance No. 64-86; and,

WHEREAS, the position of Receptionist is to be filled before the end of the year 1986;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Auditor be and they hereby are authorized to pay the salary of the position of Receptionist at the rate prescribed by Ordinance No. 64-86.

Section 2. That the amount of \$1,200.00 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund to be used for this purpose.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
