

AMENDED ORDINANCE NO. 78-86

An Ordinance to transfer and appropriate funds for the purpose of making repairs to the Bexley swimming pool and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That the sum of \$~~145,000~~^{185,000} be, and it hereby is, transferred from the unencumbered General Fund to the Swimming Pool Fund.

Section 2: That the sum of \$~~145,000~~^{185,000} be, and it hereby is, appropriated and set aside from the Swimming Pool Fund for the purpose of paying the cost of repairs to the Bexley swimming pool and purchasing fixtures and equipment in connection therewith.

Section 3: That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into one or more contracts for the improvements specified in Section 2 hereof, the total costs of which shall not exceed the amount specified and appropriated.

Section 4: That the contracts authorized herein, when required by law, shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law.

Section 5: That this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety since it is necessary to commence such repairs at the earliest possible date in order to open the Bexley swimming pool on May 23, 1987; and, therefore, such Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
