SUBSTITUTE RESOLUTION NO. 6 - 87

To provide for the submission to the electors of the City of Bexley, Ohio, at the General Election to be held on November 3, 1987, an ordinance to enact and provide for an income tax at the rate of Two (2) percent.

WHEREAS, Article XII, Section 3 of the Ohio Constitution provides that, "Laws may be passed providing for:...
(B) The taxation of incomes, and the rates of such taxation may be either uniform or graduated, and may be applied to such incomes and with such exemptions as may be provided by law"; and,

WHEREAS, Section 718.01 of the Ohio Revised Code provides that "No municipal corporation shall levy a tax on income at a rate in excess of one per cent without having obtained the approval of the excess by a majority of the electors of the municipality voting on the question at a general, primary, or special election."; and,

WHEREAS, there exists a need for revenue for the purpose of general municipal operations, maintenance, new equipment, and capital improvements of the city and the retirement of bonds and notes issued by the City; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That pursuant to Article XII, Section 3 of the Ohio Constitution and Chapter 718 of the Revised Code of Ohio, there is hereby submitted to the electors of the City of Bexley for their approval or rejection at the General Election to be held on November 3, 1987, an ordinance to provide for an income tax of Two (2) percent.

Section 2. That the Clerk of this Council shall forthwith certify a copy of this resolution and the ordinance providing for an income tax at the rate of Two (2) percent and shall forthwith file said certified resolution and ordinance with the Board of Elections of Franklin County, Ohio.
