


ORDINANCE NO. 9 - 87

An Ordinance to transfer and appropriate funds for the purpose of making repairs and alterations to the Bexley Swimming Pool at Jeffrey Park and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 78-86, adopted December 9, 1985, transferred from the unencumbered General Fund and appropriated from the Swimming Pool Fund the sum of \$185,000.00 for the necessary repairs and alterations to the Bexley Swimming Pool, and said amount was not encumbered at the end of the 1986 fiscal year; and,

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 80-86, adopted December 9, 1986, appropriated the sum of \$5,300.00 for the purpose of paying the fees of the City planning consultant, Mark Feinknopf, to prepare specifications and perform planning services in connection with repairs and alterations to the Bexley Swimming Pool and that said amount was not encumbered at the end of the 1986 fiscal year; and,

WHEREAS, bids were received on February 2, 1987 and the best and lowest bid was received from the Thomas and Marker Construction Company in the amount of \$200,500.00. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$15,500.00 be, and it hereby is, transferred from the unencumbered General Fund to the Swimming Pool Fund.

Section 2. That the sum of \$200,500.00 be, and it hereby is, appropriated and set aside from the Swimming Pool Fund for the purpose of paying the cost of repairs and alterations to the Bexley Swimming Pool.

Section 3. That the sum of \$5,300.00 be, and it hereby is, reappropriated from the Swimming Pool Fund for the purpose of paying the consulting and architectural fees of the City planning consultant, Mark Feinknopf, for planning and design services in connection with repairs and alterations to the Bexley Swimming Pool.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety; said emergency being that it is necessary to commence repairs and alterations to the Bexley Swimming Pool at the earliest possible date in order to keep within the limited construction schedule; and, therefore, this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
