

ORDINANCE NO. 10 - 87

An Ordinance to appropriate \$928.00 from the unencumbered General Fund for telephone improvements made in the City Hall lobby receptionist's area and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 65-86 appropriated \$15,000.00 for the remodeling of the City Hall lobby receptionist's area; and,

WHEREAS, \$7,958.30 was spent for the remodeling project during fiscal year 1986; and,

WHEREAS, at the end of fiscal year 1986 the balance of the funds were returned to the unencumbered General Fund; and,

WHEREAS, GTE Telsystems Corporation completed necessary telephone improvements for the receptionist's switchboard at a cost of \$928.00, which has not been paid. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That \$928.00 be, and the same hereby is, appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the payment of necessary telephone improvements made in the City Hall lobby.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, since it is necessary to pay an outstanding obligation for work that has been completed; and, therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
