A Resolution in support of Issue Four, construction of the convention center and civic arena.

WHEREAS, the facilities will bring out-of-town visitors to spend millions of dollars annually in hotels, restaurants, and retail shops; and,

WHEREAS, new jobs will be created as a result of the center and arena; and,

WHEREAS, the proposal includes private business development and thus reduces the operating costs to be paid by taxpayers; and,

WHEREAS, an increased number of visitors will contribute to the Columbus hotel/motel tax, which helps fund essential city services; and,
