

ORDINANCE NO. 11 - 87

An Ordinance to transfer and appropriate funds for the installation and monitoring of a fire alarm system at the Jeffrey Mansion, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$3,497.00 should be, and it hereby is, transferred from the unencumbered General Fund to the Capital Improvement Fund.

Section 2. That the sum of \$3,497.00 should be, and it hereby is, appropriated and set aside from the Capital Improvement Fund for the purpose of paying the cost of installation and monitoring of a local evacuation and spot fire alarm system at the Jeffrey Mansion.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, since it is desirable to have a modern fire alarm system in place at the earliest possible time for the protection of the general public and municipal employees who occupy the Jeffrey Mansion; and, therefore, such Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
