

ORDINANCE NO. 16 - 87

An Ordinance to authorize a contract between the Bexley Board of Health and the Life Care Alliance, to appropriate funds and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$5,258 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the purpose of paying a portion of the costs of the meals on wheels and life care dining programs provided to residents of the City of Bexley by the Life Care Alliance.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into a contract on behalf of the City Board of Health with the Life Care Alliance for the provision of the meals on wheels and life care dining programs to Bexley residents.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety in that Bexley residents require the services provided by the Life Care Alliance on an uninterrupted basis, which Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
