

ORDINANCE NO. 77 -87

An Ordinance to appropriate funds to pay the salaries of the Health Commissioner and the City Sanitarian, to increase the salary of the City Sanitarian and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY,
OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$1,400 is hereby appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying the salary of the Health Commissioner.

Section 2. That the sum of \$1,000 is hereby appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying the salary of the City Sanitarian.

Section 3. That the pay of the City Sanitarian shall be fixed at \$8 to \$9 per hour effective July 1, 1987 to be paid periodically as invoiced, not to exceed \$4,600 per year at the discretion of the Mayor and Auditor.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall go into effect at the earliest date provided by law.
