

SUBSTITUTE ORDINANCE NO. 80-87

An Ordinance to appropriate funds to settle a damage claim as a result of a defective water meter.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$432.55 be, and it hereby is, appropriated from the unencumbered Water Fund to reimburse Mark Levison of 740 Euclaire Avenue, Bexley, Ohio, for the cost of property destroyed by water damage.

Section 2. That the Auditor and Mayor are hereby authorized and directed to issue a warrant in the amount specified in Section 1, for the total settlement of this claim in accordance with the paid receipt as submitted by the Claimant.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
