

ORDINANCE NO. 8-88

An Ordinance to approve the editing and inclusion of certain ordinances as parts of the various component codes of the Codified Ordinances, to provide for the adoption of new matter in the updated and revised Codified Ordinances, to publish the enactment of such new matter, to repeal ordinances in conflict therewith, and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, The Justinian Publishing Company has completed its updating and revision of the Codified Ordinances of the City; and

WHEREAS, various ordinances of a general and permanent nature that have been passed by Council since the date of the last updating of the Codified Ordinances (September 19, 1984) have been included in the Codified Ordinances of the City; and

WHEREAS, certain changes were made in the Codified Ordinances to bring City law into conformity with State law; now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. The editing, arrangement and numbering or renumbering of the following ordinances and parts of ordinances are hereby approved as parts of the various component codes of the Codified Ordinances of the City, so as to conform to the classification and numbering system of the Codified Ordinances:

Section 3. The following sections are hereby repealed:

444.01, 444.05 to 444.11, 636.10, 642.22, 642.29, 642.30, 672.11, 672.13

Section 4. All ordinances and resolutions and parts thereof that are in conflict with any of the provisions of the new matter approved, adopted and enacted by Section 2 hereof are hereby repealed, except as follows: The enactment of such new matter shall not be construed to affect a right or liability accrued or incurred under any legislative provision prior to the effective date of such enactment, or an action or proceeding for the enforcement of such right or liability. Such enactment shall not be construed to relieve any person from punishment for an act committed in violation of any such legislative provision or to affect an indictment or prosecution therefor. For such purposes, any such legislative provision shall continue in full force notwithstanding its repeal for the purposes of revision and recodification.

Section 5. Pursuant to Section 222.01 of the Codified Ordinances, a copy of this ordinance shall be posted, together with notice as to where a copy of the replacement pages may be reviewed and examined by interested persons, for a period of not less than fifteen days after adoption, on the bulletin board or in some other conspicuous place in the City Hall.

Section 6. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety for the reason that it is necessary to have a current codification of the legislation of the City to provide properly for the administration of government and to ensure law and order in the City, for which reasons this ordinance, including the replacement pages hereby approved, shall take effect and be in force upon and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
