

ORDINANCE NO. 15-88

An Ordinance to transfer funds from the unencumbered General Fund to the Capital Improvements Fund, to appropriate funds and authorize contracts for the purchase of services in connection with the supervision and removal of asbestos material from Jeffrey Mansion and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY,
OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$18,596.63 is hereby transferred from the unencumbered General Fund to the Capital Improvements Fund.

Section 2. That the sum of \$596.63 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvements Fund to pay for the services of Lyle Laboratories in conducting a survey of asbestos material in Jeffrey Mansion.

Section 3. That the sum of \$18,000 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvements Fund for services in connection with the removal and supervision of the removal of asbestos material from Jeffrey Mansion.

Section 4. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into contracts for the purchase of services specified above in Section 3 when and as necessary or desirable.

Section 5. That the contracts authorized herein, when required by law, shall be entered into with the lowest and best bid after advertisement according to law.

Section 6. That the contracts authorized hereby relates to services being incurred in connection with the renovation of Jeffrey Mansion, a project to be financed through the issuance of notes in the amount of \$750,000 in anticipation of the issuance of bonds, and that the General Fund shall, to the extent that proceeds are available for such purpose, be reimbursed for such expenditure from the proceeds of such note issuance.

Section 7. That this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the necessity of securing removal of asbestos material to facilitate the renovation of Jeffrey Mansion at the earliest possible date, and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
