

ORDINANCE NO. 18 -88

An Ordinance to appropriate the amount of \$11,567.43 for the purchase of a hydraulic lift assembly to be installed in the Municipal Garage and to declare an emergency.

Whereas, the amount of \$17,000.00 was appropriated in the 1987 Capital Improvements Ordinance for the purchase and installation of a hydraulic lift assembly for the Municipal Garage; and,

Whereas, bids were received in December, 1987, for said purchase but the only bid received did not meet the specifications and was rejected by the Board of Control; and,

Whereas, the amount appropriated for this purchase was not encumbered at the close of the 1987 fiscal year because a purchase contract had not been executed; and,

Whereas, new bids were received in January, 1988, and the Board of Control awarded the contract to the Jim Bryant Company in the amount of \$11,567.43 conditioned upon the necessary appropriation by City Council. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the amount of \$11,567.43 be, and it hereby is, appropriated from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund for the purchase of a hydraulic lift assembly installed in the Municipal Garage.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to replace the existing hydraulic lift which is unsafe to use because of its age and condition, and shall go into immediate force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
