

ORDINANCE NO. 19-88

An Ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 89-87 to increase the five member Bexley Charter Review Committee to seven members and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY,  
OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance NO. 89-87 be amended to read as follows:

Section 1. That there is hereby created the Bexley Charter Review Committee, consisting of ~~five~~ SEVEN electors of the City, ~~three~~ FOUR appointed by City Council, and ~~two~~ THREE to be appointed by the Mayor. The members shall serve without compensation.

The Committee shall review the Charter of the City of Bexley and report by ~~September~~ NOVEMBER 30, 1988, its recommendations to Council on any alterations, revisions, or amendments as in its judgement are necessary to update the Bexley City Charter.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety. The reason for such emergency being the broadening of membership of the Bexley Charter Review Committee to begin the process of reviewing the Bexley City Charter. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
