

ORDINANCE NO. 26-88

An Ordinance to appropriate funds from the Capital Improvements Fund, the Water Fund, the Sewer Fund and the Refuse Fund for capital improvements and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That \$59,850 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvements Fund for the purchase of equipment for the Police Department as follows:

Replacement of existing antenna and feed line on Police Repeater Base Radio System:	\$ 1,550
Two additional panels for present walkie talkie storage and recharger unit:	\$ 700
Three 1989 cruisers with police package/ accessories:	\$48,600
Replacement of Radio Room typerwriter:	\$ 800
Self-contained breathing apparatus unit and two (2) fire extinguishers for firing range area:	\$ 1,200
Replacement of breathalyzer testing unit (BAC verifier) and training:	\$ 7,000

Section 2. That \$4,700 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvements Fund for the purchase of equipment for City Hall as follows:

645s Memorywriter for Receptionist/ Secretary:	\$2,895
Update Service Department Secretary's 625 Memorywriter to 645s:	\$ 1,705

Section 3. That \$8,000 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvements Fund for the purchase of a paint machine for pavement markings for the Municipal Garage.

Section 4. That \$550 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvements Fund for the retrofitting of an existing pick-up truck with a tailgate mounted loading ramp for the Parks Department.

Section 5. That \$19,950 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvements Fund for the purchase of equipment for the Street Department as follows:

Central hydraulic system to operate the salt spreader on the snow plow on #16 dump truck:	\$ 4,500
Replacement air compressor equipped with a twin hose reel and two 50 ft. hoses:	\$14,000
Replacement barricades and small hand tools:	\$ 1,450

Section 6. That \$3,000 is hereby appropriated from the Sewer Fund for the purchase of equipment for the Sewer Department as follows:

Replacement of storm catch basin and manhole lids: \$ 2,000

Replacement of rods and tools for the sewer rodding machine: \$ 1,000

Section 7. That \$31,250 is hereby appropriated from the Refuse Fund for the purchase of equipment for the Refuse Department as follows:

Three satellite collection vehicles complete with dump bodies: \$27,000

Five commercial refuse boxes: \$ 3,000

Five pre-cast concrete trash receptacles: \$ 1,250

Section 8. That \$8,000 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvements Fund for the purchase of equipment for the Recreation Department as follows:

Photocopier: \$ 6,000

Replacement of circular slide at Jeffrey Park: \$ 2,000

Section 9. That \$133,000 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvements Fund for 1988 Street Improvement Program described in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein, of which \$72,000 is to be reimbursed from the Franklin County Permissive License Tax funds.

Section 10. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into contracts for the purchase of the goods and services specified above when and as necessary or desirable.

Section 11. That the contracts authorized herein, when required by law, shall be entered into with the lowest and best bid after advertisement according to law.

Section 12. That this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety in order to commence improvements at the earliest possible date and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
