

ORDINANCE NO. 50 -88

An Ordinance to appropriate the sum of \$1,300.00 from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of purchasing and installing a replacement air conditioning unit in the Administrative offices at Bexley City Hall, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$1,300.00 should be, and it hereby is, appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of purchasing and installing a new Bryant 565030, 2½ ton air conditioning unit in the Administrative Offices at Bexley City Hall, and removal of the existing Chrysler 1203-07 condensing unit which has a bad compressor.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency, said emergency being the necessity of providing air conditioning to the Administrative Offices during the record-breaking heat wave that exists at the present time, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
