

ORDINANCE NO. 54 -88

An Ordinance to appropriate funds from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund for the purchase and installation of a replacement air conditioning compressor for the police building, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$1,510 is hereby appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund for the purchase and installation of an air conditioner compressor for the police building.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency, said emergency being the necessity of providing air conditioning to the police building during the summer, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
