An Ordinance to appropriate funds for the Discover Columbus Economic Development Campaign.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$2,500.00 should be, and it hereby is, appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying the City's contribution to the Discover Columbus Economic Development Campaign.
