

ORDINANCE NO. 64-88

An Ordinance to transfer funds from the Bond Retirement Fund to the Capital Improvements Fund, to appropriate funds from the Capital Improvements Fund for the renovation of Jeffrey Mansion and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY,
OHIO:

Section 1: That \$653,403.37 is hereby transferred from the Bond Retirement Fund to the Capital Improvements Fund.

Section 2: That \$653,403.37 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of funding the renovation of Jeffrey Mansion.

Section 3: That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into a contract or contracts for the purchase of the goods and services specified above when and as necessary or desirable.

Section 4: That the contracts authorized herein when required by law shall be entered into with the lowest and best bid after advertisement according to law.

Section 5: That any and all actions previously taken by City officials in connection with the advertisement and approval of contracts for the renovation of Jeffrey Mansion be, and the same hereby are, ratified, confirmed and approved by and on behalf of the City.

Section 6: That this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety in order to assure the uninterrupted performance of services in connection with the renovation of Jeffrey Mansion and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
