

ORDINANCE NO. 65-88

An ordinance to appropriate funds from the unencumbered General Fund to authorize a contract with National Revenue Corporation for collection services and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY,
OHIO:

Section 1: That \$4,000 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purchase of collection services with respect to unpaid fines due the Bexley Mayor's Court.

Section 2: That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into a contract with National Revenue Corporation for the collection services specified in Section 1.

Section 3: That this ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety in order to commence collection activities at the earliest practicable date and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
