An Ordinance to appropriate funds from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund for the purchase and installation of a replacement air conditioning condensor unit for the Water and Auditor's Departments in the City Hall building, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$1,917.00 is hereby appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund for the purchase and installation of an air conditioning unit for the City Hall building.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency, said emergency being the necessity of providing air conditioning to the Water and Auditor's Departments in the City Hall building, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
